Understanding your challenges

Following the *Horvath Review of Medicare Locals*, March 2014, Primary Health Networks will be formed to:

- improve patient outcomes and experience by coordinating and integrating care within a local healthcare community
- decrease fragmentation of services
- reduce variation in care



Local health communities need to engage with providers across their cohort to develop standardised clinical pathways that focus on the needs of the local population, down to the individual patient journey.

Any system implementation needs to demonstrate its ability to enhance, not impede, a clinician's workflow, integrate with other health information systems and be seen as an enabler in meeting eHealth requirements.
